Our board only meets a few times a year – we are not asking for a huge time commitment.


We are still in need of neighbors to serve on the welcoming committee and the special events committee.

Nominating Rules & Guidelines

Please consider being on the Board for a year or two. We know everyone is busy, and it does not take a lot of time to be a member. It is needed to keep a variety of voices on the issues that impact the neighborhood.

Rules

- Submit only one nomination ballot per household.
- Nominations will be taken at the meeting.
- Terms are for only one year at a time.

Guidelines

- Before nominating a candidate for an important office in our association, the board recommends that you consider the following:
- How well do you know the nominee?
- Will the nominee represent the entire community objectively?
- Is the nominee willing to serve if elected?
- Is the nominee available to attend the quarterly Board of Directors meetings as deemed necessary to conduct the business of the association?



Please clean up your grass clippings in the road when you mow to keep them out of the drain entries. Those road drains flow directly into the Boman Drain behind Meadowbrook Park Neighborhood and we are being charged to clean it out.

Yard waste can be put in brown yard waste bags or in 30 gal containers with large X or clearly marked yard waste. Branches are to be no more than (2) two inches in diameter, no longer than (4) four feet in length, and must be bundled/tied with rope or twine. Bundles and containers must weigh less than 50 pounds. No tree stumps or trunks are accepted. No compost will be accepted in plastic bags.

The last pick up will be *Nov. 25, 2024*!

Don't wait too long to pick up fall leaves! Service will start again next April.

Sign Concerns


This fall we had someone turning off the power to the entrance sign on multiple occasions. We placed a lock on the box and have not had a problem again.


