

All neighbors should have received the letter from the Flushing Township regarding the final cost of the Road Repaving Project using the Eastern Asphalt Construction. The letter detailed the following costs:

You have until September 30, 2022 to pay in full and avoid paying any additional interest or to make your first payment. The first year's payment due is \$327.93 and each of the 10 years it will decrease slightly as you will only be charged what is remaining on the principal.
